Leader begins with the following:

If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us; but if we confess our sins, God who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. *I John 1:8, 9*

Confession of Sin

Leader and family together, all kneeling

Most merciful God,

we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed,

by what we have done,

and by what we have left undone.

We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent.

For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ,

have mercy on us and forgive us;

that we may delight in your will,

and walk in your ways,

to the glory of your name. Amen.

The designated Leader alone stands and says

Almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us all our sins through our Lord Jesus Christ, strengthen us in all goodness, and by the power of the Holy Spirit keep us in eternal life. *Amen*.

The Invitation to the Psalms

All stand

Leader Lord, open our lips.

Family And our mouth shall proclaim your praise.

Leader and Family

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever Amen.

Leader and Family

The Lord is full of compassion and mercy: Come let us adore him.

L=Leader; F=Family (Call and response)

Psalm 100

L: Be joyful in the Lord, all you lands;

F: serve the Lord with gladness and come before his presence with a song.

F: he himself has made us, and we are his; we are his people and the sheep of his pasture.

L: Enter his gates with thanksgiving;

F: go into his courts with praise; give thanks to him and call upon his Name.

L: For the Lord is good;

F: his mercy is everlasting; and his faithfulness endures from age to age.

The Psalms Appointed:

41

- 1 L: Happy are they who consider the poor and needy! the LORD will deliver them in the time of trouble.
- 2 F: The LORD preserves them and keeps them alive, so that they may be happy in the land; he does not hand them over to the will of their enemies.
- 3 L: The LORD sustains them on their sickbed and ministers to them in their illness.
- 4 **F:** I said, "LORD, be merciful to me; heal me, for I have sinned against you."
- 5 **L:** My enemies are saying wicked things about me: When will he die, and his name perish?"
- 6. **F:** Even if they come to see me, they speak empty words; heir heart collects false rumors; they go outside and spread them.
- 7 **L:** All my enemies whisper together about me and devise evil against me.

- 8 **F:** "A deadly thing," they say, "has fastened on him; * he has taken to his bed and will never get up again."
- 9 L: Even my best friend, whom I trusted, who broke bread with me, * has lifted up his heel and turned against me.
- 10 **F:** But you, O LORD, be merciful to me and raise me up, * and I shall repay them.
- 11 **L:** By this I know you are pleased with me, * that my enemy does not triumph over me.
- 12 **F:** In my integrity you hold me fast, * and shall set me before your face for ever.
- 13 **L:** Blessed be the LORD God of Israel, * from age to age. Amen. Amen.

- 1 **F:** You tyrant, why do you boast of wickedness against the godly all day long?
- 2 L: You plot ruin;your tongue is like a sharpened razor,O worker of deception.
- 3 **F:** You love evil more than good and lying more than speaking the truth.
- 4 L: You love all words that hurt, O you deceitful tongue.
- 5 **F:** Oh, that God would demolish you utterly, topple you, and snatch you from your dwelling, and root you out of the land of the living!
- 6 L: The righteous shall see and tremble, and they shall laugh at him, saying,

- 7 **F:** "This is the one who did not take God for a refuge, * but trusted in great wealth and relied upon wickedness."
- 8 L: But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God; * I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever.
- 9 F: I will give you thanks for what you have done * and declare the goodness of your Name in the presence of the godly.

- F. Nor the hope of the poor be taken away.
- L: Create in us clean hearts, O God;
- F. And sustain us by your Holy Spirit.
