Confession of Sin

Leader and family together, all kneeling

Most merciful God,

we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed,

by what we have done,

and by what we have left undone.

We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent.

For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ,

have mercy on us and forgive us;

that we may delight in your will,

and walk in your ways,

to the glory of your name. *Amen.*

The designated Leader alone stands and says

Almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us all our sins through our Lord Jesus Christ, strengthen us in all goodness, and by the power of the Holy Spirit keep us in eternal life. *Amen.*

The Invitation to the Psalms

All stand

Leader Lord, open our lips.

Family And our mouth shall proclaim your praise.

Leader and Family

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever Amen. Alleluia.

Leader and Family

Alleluia. The Lord is risen indeed: Come let us adore him. Alleluia.

L=Leader; F=Family (Call and response)

1 Corinthians 5:7-8; Romans 6:9-11; 1 Corinthians 15:20-22

L: Alleluia.

F: Christ our Passover has been sacrificed for us;

L: therefore let us keep the feast,

F: Not with old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil,

L: but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. Alleluia.

F: Christ being raised from the dead will never die again;

L: death no longer has dominion over him.

F: The death that he died, he died to sin, once for all;

L: but the life he lives, he lives to God.

F: So also consider yourselves dead to sin,

L: and alive to God in Jesus Christ our Lord. Alleluia.

F: Christ has been raised from the dead,

L: the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep.

F: For since by a man came death,

L: by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead.

F: For as in Adam all die,

L: so in Christ shall all be made alive. Alleluia.

he sustains the orphan and widow,
but frustrates the way of the wicked.

your God, O Zion, throughout all generations.

- 1 **L:** Hallelujah!
How good it is to sing praises to our God!
how pleasant it is to honor him with praise!
- 2 **F:** The LORD rebuilds Jerusalem;
he gathers the exiles of Israel.
- 3 **L:** He heals the brokenhearted
and binds up their wounds.
- 4 **F:** He counts the number of the stars
and calls them all by their names.
- 5 **L:** Great is our LORD and mighty in power;
there is no limit to his wisdom.
- 6 **F:** The LORD lifts up the lowly,
but casts the wicked to the ground.
- 7 **L:** Sing to the LORD with thanksgiving;
make music to our God upon the harp.
- 8 **F:** He covers the heavens with clouds
and prepares rain for the earth;
- 9 **L:** He makes grass to grow upon the mountains
and green plants to serve mankind.

- 10 **F:** He provides food for flocks and herds
and for the young ravens when they cry.
- 11 **L:** He is not impressed by the might of a horse;
he has no pleasure in the strength of a man;
- 12 **F:** But the LORD has pleasure in those who fear him,
in those who await his gracious favor.
- 13 **L:** Worship the LORD, O Jerusalem;
praise your God, O Zion;
- 14 **F:** For he has strengthened the bars of your gates;
he has blessed your children within you.
- 15 **L:** He has established peace on your borders;
he satisfies you with the finest wheat.
- 16 **F:** He sends out his command to the earth,
and his word runs very swiftly.
- 17 **L:** He gives snow like wool;
he scatters hoarfrost like ashes.
- 18 **L:** He scatters his hail like bread crumbs;
who can stand against his cold?
- 19 **F:** He sends forth his word and melts them;
he blows with his wind, and the waters flow.
- 20 **L:** He declares his word to Jacob,
his statutes and his judgments to Israel.
- 21 **F:** He has not done so to any other nation;
to them he has not revealed his judgments.
Hallelujah!

- F. For only in you can we live in safety.
- L. Lord, keep this nation under your care;
- F. And guide us in the way of justice and truth.
- L. Let your way be known upon earth;
- F. Your saving health among all nations.
- L. Let not the needy, O Lord, be forgotten;
- F. Nor the hope of the poor be taken away.
- L. Create in us clean hearts, O God;
- F. And sustain us with your Holy Spirit.

The Leader then says the following Prayer

O God, who for our redemption gave your only-begotten Son to the death of the cross, and by his glorious resurrection delivered us from the power of our enemy: Grant us so to die daily to sin, that we may evermore live with him in the joy of his resurrection; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. *Amen.*
