**Confession of Sin**

*Leader and family together, all kneeling*

Most merciful God,  
we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed,  
by what we have done,  
and by what we have left undone.  
We have not loved you with our whole heart;  
we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.  
We are truly sorry and we humbly repent.  
For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ,  
have mercy on us and forgive us;  
that we may delight in your will,  
and walk in your ways,  
to the glory of your name. *Amen.*

*The designated Leader alone stands and says*

Almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us all our sins through our Lord Jesus Christ,  
strengthen us in all goodness, and by the power of the Holy Spirit keep us in eternal life. *Amen.*

**The Invitation to the Psalms**

*All stand*

*Leader* Lord, open our lips.

*Family* And our mouth shall proclaim your praise.

*Leader and Family*

*1 Corinthians 5:7-8; Romans 6:9-11; 1 Corinthians 15:20-22*

L: Alleluia.

F: Christ our Passover has been sacrificed for us;

L: therefore let us keep the feast,

F: Not with old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil,

L: but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. Alleluia.

F: Christ being raised from the dead will never die again;

L: death no longer has dominion over him.

F: The death that he died, he died to sin, once for all;

L: but the life he lives, he lives to God.

F: So also consider yourselves dead to sin,

L: and alive to God in Jesus Christ our Lord. Alleluia.

F: Christ has been raised from the dead,

L: the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep.

F: For since by a man came death,

L: by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead.

F: For as in Adam all die,

L: so in Christ shall all be made alive. Alleluia.

- 13 L: I will offer you sacrifices of fat beasts  
with the smoke of rams;  
I will give you oxen and goats.
- 14 F: Come and listen, all you who fear God,  
and I will tell you what he has done for me.
- 15 L: I called out to him with my mouth,  
and his praise was on my tongue.
- 16 F: If I had found evil in my heart,  
the Lord would not have heard me;
- 17 L: But in truth God has heard me;  
he has attended to the voice of my prayer.
- 18 F: Blessed be God, who has not rejected my prayer,  
nor withheld his love from me.

## 67

1 **L:** May God be merciful to us and bless us,  
show us the light of his countenance and come to us.

2 **F:** Let your ways be known upon earth,  
your saving health among all nations.

3 **L:** Let the peoples praise you, O God;  
let all the peoples praise you.

4 **F:** Let the nations be glad and sing for joy,  
for you judge the peoples with equity  
and guide all the nations upon earth.

5 **L:** Let the peoples praise you, O God;  
let all the peoples praise you.

6 **F:** The earth has brought forth her increase;  
may God, our own God, give us his blessing.

## **The Apostles' Creed**

was crucified, died, and was buried.

and is seated at the right hand of the Father.  
He will come again to judge the living and the dead.  
I believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the holy catholic Church,  
the communion of saints,  
the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body,  
and the life everlasting. Amen.

L: The Lord be with you.

F: And also with you.

L: Let us pray.

- L. Day by day we bless you;
- F. We praise your name for ever.
- L. Lord, keep us from all sin today;
- F. Have mercy upon us, Lord, have mercy.
- L. Lord, show us your love and mercy;
- F. For we put our trust in you.
- L. In you, Lord, is our hope;
- F. And we shall never hope in vain.

*The Leader then says the following Prayer*

O God, you have made of one blood all the peoples of the earth, and sent your blessed Son to preach peace to those who are far off and to those who are near: Grant that people everywhere may seek after you and find you; bring the nations into your fold; pour out your Spirit upon all flesh; and hasten the coming of your kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

*The Leader and family then say the following Prayers*

#### **A Prayer for Sundays**

Amen.

*Leader and Family*
